- Designed to be highly intuitive, Numberland provides spoken hints to help preschoolers and kindergarteners navigate confidently through each game or learning option, all of which focus on numbers 0-9.
- In addition to the engaging interactivity, this app's perfect for introducing budding mathematicians to the mechanics of counting and numbers through a series of fun games. Montessori spindles provide a great introduction and reinforcement of the concept of zero, or "nothing," while in the 123 section, kids explore each number by tracing it and counting objects in the picture.





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Reading Eggs: Eggy 100


